JUNIOR GREYHOUNDS CHEERLEADING

All Registration Forms and Participation Fees must be received no later than two (2) weeks prior to the start of season.

Pre-season practice begins mid-August.

PROGRAM

THE JUNIOR GREYHOUND CHEERLEADING PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- ✓ **5 organized Cheerleading Squads** structured by age and weight (ages 4-14 years)
- ✓ **No tryouts** – Just sign up and show your team spirit.
- ✓ **Full season of Cheerleading** that runs from August until November.
- ✓ **Practices** that are held 2-3 times per week in August and 2 times per week once school starts.
- ✓ **Exciting games** that are scheduled once per week from September – November
- ✓ **Trained coaches** that teach fundamental skills and qualities so kids can fulfill their greatest potential as cheerleaders.
- ★ **THE BEST OF EVERYTHING** – kids will learn not only the basics of cheerleading but also the importance of a good attitude, teamwork, spirit and commitment.

FEES

PARTICIPATION FEES:

Cheerleading: \$150.00* Nonrefundable Registration Fee per participant (Families with more than one child participating in program will receive a discount on additional registrations.)

Uniform Security: When equipment and/or uniforms are distributed a fully refundable \$150 security check will be required. This check will be held by the Association until the end of the year. At that time, once all uniforms are returned and each set of parents has worked 4 hours in support of the program (i.e. concession sales, merchandise sales, field set-up, field take-down, etc.) the check will be destroyed.

Volunteer Work: Parents are required to volunteer 5 hours per family with a minimum of 3 hours at concession stand during the season. To ensure your participation, you will be required to submit a work bond of \$100 per family at your child's first practice. This bond will be held until you complete your hours. If you do not volunteer your required hours, your check will be cashed. Please bring a check to the first day of practice made out to NBJGAA with the player's name on the check in the amount of \$100, or your child will not be allowed to practice.

FUNDRAISER: All players are **required** to participate in the fundraiser to support the program. All players must sell 3 tickets to the Liberty Lake Fun Day event for \$60.00. More information can be found on the website once the details are finalized.
